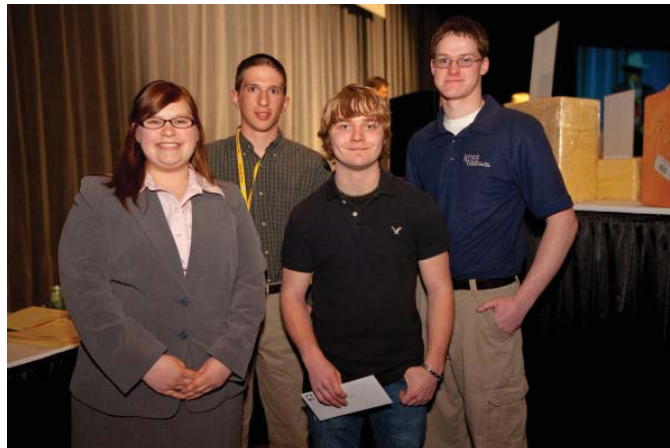
Applications must be returned to WCMA by February 24, 2012. The winning applicants will be announced March 23, 2012. Winners will be invited to accept their awards at the International Cheese Technology Exposition, on April 11, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Priority will be given to students emphasizing studies that may lead to a career in the food and dairy supply industry. This includes studies leading to a career in business management, marketing, engineering, quality assurance or any other profession applicable to the supply industry.

The scholarship is open to students attending any college, university or technical school in the United States. It is also open to high school seniors registered to attend a qualifying school. Applicants **must** supply current GPA (verified by transcript), a letter of recommendation and a completed application form.
